They never taught us why said components were bad. For example if I had a sine wave coming out of a board and was supposed to have a square wave I knew to follow the signal back to a capacitor and could say that capacitor x was bad. ITT has taught me the ins and outs of the electronics why it was a capacitor that was bad and not a resistor, why it went bad and how to fix it so that it will not go bad again.

During my time at ITT I have had the help and support of a wide variety of teacher from Mr. Elliot who taught math to Al Foy who specialized in electronics but could help in anything that you may need help with. 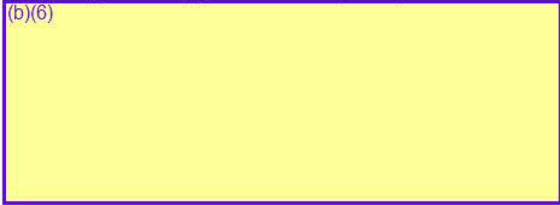

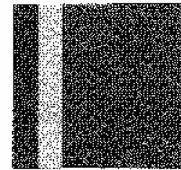
